Passion For Spreading God's Word

Rev David Cher, Lord's Day, 13 October 2024

Beloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Our Creator God has created us human beings in His image, which includes having emotions and feelings. As such, there are many things in this world that can attract, distract, and consume us, for example, our passions, emotions, ambitions, and goals. We should be reminded of the words of George MacDonald, a Scottish pastor and author, "There is nothing eternal but that which loves and can be loved [God], and love is ever climbing towards the consummation when such shall be the universe, imperishable, divine [the new Heaven and the new Earth]. Therefore all that is not beautiful in the beloved [us as humans], all that comes between and is not of love's kind, must be destroyed."

The first question and answer of the Westminster Shorter Catechism states in this way: Question 1: 'What is the chief end of man?'; and Answer: 'Man's chief end is to glorify God, and to enjoy him forever'. We are thus reminded that everything in our lives cannot and should not be excluded from the holy and sacred worshipful service of our Almighty God. This would in turn mean and imply that the social and relational structures and circles that we find ourselves even in our family and society are not merely meant for our improvement and advancement, but also for the spreading and advancement of the Gospel and Kingdom Work.

How is each of us getting ourselves involved and active in the Gospel Work?

First, we must not limit our spiritual growth to our internal or inner aspects and leave out the external aspect of blessing others with the Gospel too. It is surely good and needful to dig deep and

get ourselves rooted in our biblical essentials (Col. 2:7a "Rooted and built up in him, and established in the faith..."). But do we just stop there and be satisfied with our spiritual head knowledge? We must realise that any Christian education must result in a holistic spiritual transformation as put forth by Dr. Howard Hendricks "Secular education seeks to make better, more effective, more successful, more intelligent people. The Christian educator aspires to nothing less than the transformation of a believer into the image of Christ". An essential part of a transformed life in Christ is to take to heart what Christ has commissioned us to do and wholeheartedly put our soul's efforts into it.

Second, each of us needs to realise that we are to also do our personal Gospel Work as we are commanded to go and make our impact for the Kingdom of God (noting the verb "go" and "unto" in Matt. 28:18-20, Acts 1:8 and Acts 13:47). The nature of our missional work can be carried out both in our home country of Singapore as well as other nations in the world. Let us be motivated and prepared to be equipped and trained to carry out our evangelistic work locally (Eph. 4:12 "...the perfecting [maturing] of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the Body of Christ"), as well as willing to respond to the call of God to the nations. Let us a local Body of Christ display our diverse callings in response to the global mission of God. As John Piper remarks "Missions exists because worship doesn't".

Third, let us persevere and keep ourselves always faithful and actively serving the LORD regardless of our age and in whatever means and avenues. This would ensure that our love and service for Him would not grow cold and indifferent (Matt. 24:12 "And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold").
