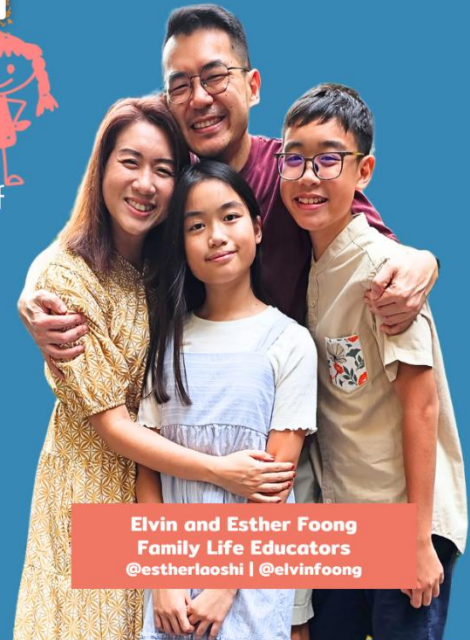

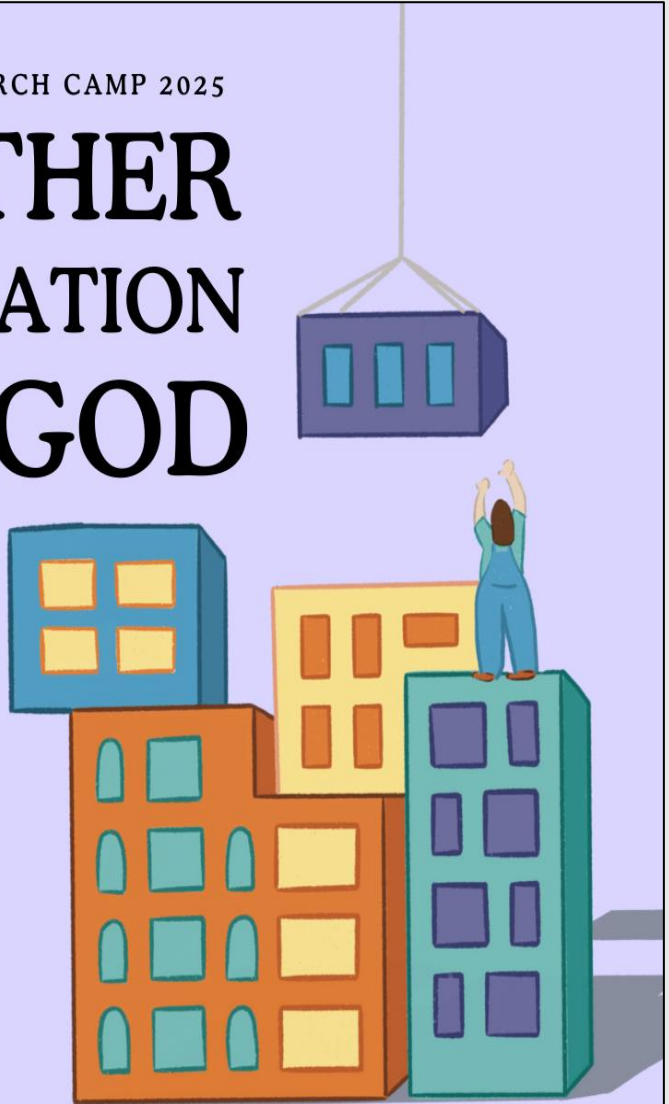

Missions: The Mission That Matters

Rev David Cher, Lord's Day, 9 March 2025

Beloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. As followers of Christ, we are certainly called and reminded to be part of God's mission to reach a lost, broken, and hurting world (Acts 1:8 "But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto Me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth"). But how then is this knowledge lived out or enfleshed in and through our lives?

It is easy and convenient for us to merely support missions efforts from afar, without ever taking the next step to get personally involved. We can be **praying** for the needs of the world and the missionaries who serve, especially for that Galilee Church is connected and partnering with; **giving** and supporting missions efforts financially, especially for those who are called and sent out from our midst into the mission field; **attending** a missions conference, event, talk or even today's Missions Sunday sermon and be inspired and motivated by what has been shared and talked about, and **sharing** missions-related posts or articles on social media. But what if God is calling for our personal involvement in missions rather than our mere afar off efforts?

First of all, **our heart attitude toward missions** should and must change! Some questions that we can ask ourselves regarding our missional heart or mindset: 1) Am I truly living a life that is on mission for God or am I merely trying to fulfil my personal goals and ambitions; 2) Am I willing to take risks and stepping out of my comfort zone to share the gospel with others? 3) Am I using my God-blessed resources (time, spiritual gifts and talents) to support missions efforts?

Having such a heart attitude and mindset should then **result in missional actions** such as engaging in evangelism and discipleship efforts in our own church, and surrounding neighborhoods and communities, intentionally looking out and searching for opportunities through a locally-based organisation or ministry to serve especially those who are marginalised or under-resourced, participating in a short-term mission trip or project during which we can serve and learn alongside others, and eventually considering long-term missions service, whether domestically or internationally.

This would certainly mean and entail that we overcome various obstacles and so-called excuses in our lives such as: 1) **Busyness**: Feeling too busy or overwhelmed with our own lives and responsibilities and thus no time for any missions effort; 2) **Comfort and complacency**: Feeling like we're doing enough already, and not wanting to rock the boat or disrupt the routine of our comfortable lives; 3) **Lack of knowledge or training**: Feeling like we don't have the necessary skills or knowledge to get involved in missions, but this can be built up or equipped in the actual process of serving in the missions context; 4) **Fear**: Fear of the unknown, fear of failure, or fear of being outside our comfort zones.

So, what is holding you back? Is it busyness, comfort and complacency, lack of knowledge or training, or fear? Whatever it is, let us overcome it together. Let us take the first step, make the first move, and start the journey of your missions involvement! Let us be reminded that all of us have a role to play in the grand narrative of God's mission. Will you take responsibility for your part in the story? Will you get involved, get engaged, and get passionate about missions? God Bless!
