### **Heart Unto Christ!**

Pastor Simon, Lord's Day, 1 June 2025

rethren,
65th Anniversary Greetings in the Name of the Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ! Praise and thank our Lord, the Head and Chief shepherd of our church who sustained and protected our church faithfully for the last 65 years. He will do the same as we move forward with His mandate for our church. To Him be the glory forever! Amen (Rom 11:36b). In the same breath, we thank our forefathers in the faith who established a model for us to emulate and now by God's grace, we must pass it down to the next generation.

In Psalm 100, the Psalmist exuberantly call on the people who experienced His faithfulness from generation to generation to serve the LORD with gladness (v:2), enter His Presence with joy, be thankful to Him, and praise and bless His Holy Name (v.4), for the Lord is good; His mercy is everlasting; and His truth endureth to all generations" (v.5). How befitting for us on this occasion as we celebrate the Church Anniversary. Our posture before God is crucial for the Lord He is God; it is He that hath made us" (v:3). It is awesome to come before the Lord God Almighty.

### The Psalmist exhorts—Serve the Lord Actively

Every Galilean is to serve the Lord and serve the Lord only and always. If you are already serving, press on fervently. Ignore the setbacks that weigh you down, the unfulfilling experiences that beset you, instead, press on and fulfil your calling to His glory. Just do your work faithfully! Understandably, for certain valid reasons, you may have "taken leave" from the Lord's service. Don't stay away too long. Return to work quickly! The Psalmist enthused God's people, the sheep of His pasture, to come joyfully before the Lord, remember who they are serving, and serve with thanksgiving in our hearts.

What does "serving the Lord" mean to you? We must not confine our service to church alone, it extends to our homes, workplaces, and in our social circles as witnesses and ambassadors of Christ. We must avoid dichotomising our activities sacred and secular. Our life belongs to the Lord—serve Him diligently!

Serve The Lord Gladly! What does it look like when a person serves the Lord with gladness? In Deut 10:12 "... serve the Lord thy God with <u>ALL</u> thy heart and with <u>ALL</u> thy soul." In the Lord's service, we involve our total being. We give our everything. When doing things without engaging our hearts, would be mechanical, superficial and unsatisfactory work in the eyes of the Lord. Note here, Paul's exhortation in Rom 12:11, "Not slothful in business; fervent in spirit; serving the Lord." Paul himself had suffered scores of impediments yet his fervour in the Lord's service is highly impressive and entirely wholehearted.

A good starting point for our service to God is to remember Who God is, and who we are. We belong to the Lord. Jesus redeemed us at Calvary! Consequently, the Lord is our Master, and we are His humble servants always. Though we are unworthy and undeserving servants, our Lord lovingly and graciously upholds us and finds delight in us (Isaiah 42:1).

Serve the Lord Aright! The palmist says, "Know the Lord is God" v3. When meeting with success, blessed with impressive talents and gifts, coupled with applause and praises of man, we gradually gather prominence in the eyes of people, and the shift of focus away from the Lord to men may take place. Needful here to remind ourselves of the words of John the Baptist who said, "He (Christ) must increase, and I must decrease". In 3:30.

A serving heart is a heart surrendered to the Lord unreservedly and relies fully on Him. A heart that loves God and His people, a heart that is right with God and with man, a heart that desires to serve God and the brethren humbly, rendering all glory to Christ Jesus. Brethren, let us keep on serving God, and serving Him joyfully, "looking unto Jesus the Author and Finisher of our faith" (Heb 12:2) .... till that glorious day, when we will hear our loving Saviour and Master say: "Well done, thou good and faithful servant" (Matt 25:21).
