Persevere In Christ!

Pastor Simon, Lord's Day, 4 May 2025

rethren,
Greetings in the Name of the Lord and Saviour
Jesus Christ! Life has been tough for some of
our brethren as they persevere in their struggle
with their physical illnesses and challenges. Many
questions, rise and fall in our minds. Dreams of better
days seem to be at a distance. Whatever remedies are
assumed through physical exercises, diet and
medication only give temporal relief in most cases.
However, their boldness in Christ, persistence in the
Lord's service, and their complete rest in the will of the
Lord motivate the congregation to excel in the Lord.

The Lord never promised anyone of us a painless, perpetual success, and endowed with plenty in this life. Shortfalls are guaranteed in the curse package (Gen 3:14-19) when man fell into sin. Interestingly, their disobedience did not prevent God's love, grace and mercies upon them. Though we live in this broken world we will experience God's comfort, grace, strength, and refuge as our first parents did in the Garden of Eden.

A story was told about a farmer who walked around his farm to take stock of his losses after a fire had destroyed his farm. When he came to the chicken coop, he saw the charred carcass of a mother hen. Using his foot to turn the carcass over, he was surprised to see live chicks under it! Apparently, the mother hen had died protecting her chicks from the fire. Here, the words of the Psalmist pop up in our minds, "He shall cover thee with His feathers, and under His wings shalt thou trust: His truth shall be thy shield and buckler" Ps 91:4. What a Blessed Assurance! God's sovereign protection covers us, His beloved children, from the ever-present dangers and terrors which surround us daily in this fallen, unpredictable and treacherous world.

Christians are truly blessed! We are not always aware of imminent danger. But God is, and He protects us! I remember the testimony of one of our members who had a near-death escape from the 2015 Bangkok bomb blast. He was contemplating dining out where the incident was about to take place, or "Tapau" dinner back to the hotel, a mundane matter indeed. He

couldn't have known of the impending disaster. But he has a God who foreknew all things, laid upon his heart to "tapau" his dinner. Barely he had walked three blocks away when the bomb went off, killing and injuring several people.

We have a Living God Who watches over us – we are "the apple of His eye" (Zech 2:8) -- attentively and lovingly, 24/7. Caught in "unfavourable situations", we need not panic for we can abide under God's widespread wings. The illness that hits us suddenly, the condition we deal with daily, the acidic workplace we work in, friends who turned foes, misunderstandings that threaten to fracture the family, and other harsh twists of life -- are times we can confidently seek shelter, protection, counsel and direction under God's wings.

However, in our fallen nature, we don't always appreciate our divine provision. In the face of crisis or calamity, we seek help and refuge from prominent and "promising" people, relying on our years of experience, acquired wisdom, and knowledge to quickly fix the situation. But the truly trusted resources for us in our stormy days will be prayer, promises in the Scriptures, recalling God's faithfulness in the past, and testimonies of others who had gone before us will do us well. Sadly, more often than not, it is only when we are at wit's end, with "no other choice", then, as a last resort, turn desperately to God. Our dear Lord lamented: "... How often would I have gathered thy children together, as a hen doth gather her brood under her wings, and ve would not!" (Luke 13:34). Truly, "God is our Refuge and Strength, a very present help in trouble" (Psalm 46:1).

Brethren, let us trust in God and humbly receive the tender care and divine love that God wants to lavish on us. He is aware of what we will experience in this life, and he turns that which is no good into something very good in enriching our relationship with Him and forming in us a visible glowing faith where we edify the church through our ups and downs in this life (Col 1:24). Our Heavenly Father is beside us to help us walk through our earthly journey... till we reach our Heavenly Home! Thanks be to God! God Bless!
