Living Kingdom Priorities

Rev David Cher, Lord's Day, 8 June 2025

Beloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. As believers, we are called to live a life that reflects the values and priorities of God's kingdom. In a world that often promotes self-centeredness and materialism, it's essential to intentionally cultivate kingdom priorities and values in our lives. By doing so, we can experience the abundant life that God has promised and make a meaningful impact to others.

Developing kingdom priorities begins with seeking first the kingdom of God. As Jesus said, "But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you." (Matt. 6:33). This means that we prioritise our relationship with God above all else, recognizing that our connection with Him is the foundation of our lives. By seeking God's kingdom, we can experience the peace, joy, and fulfilment that comes from living a life aligned with His purposes. As the psalmist wrote, "Blessed are they that keep His testimonies, and that seek Him with the whole heart." (Ps. 119:2).

Trusting in God's sovereignty and goodness is a critical aspect of kingdom priorities. As believers, we are called to trust in God's plan and purposes, even when we don't understand or can't see the outcome. This involves surrendering our lives to God, seeking His guidance, and trusting in His goodness. As believers, we are called to show love and kindness to others, not just in words, but in actions (1 John 3:18 "My little children, let us not love in word, neither in tongue; but in deed and in truth"). This can involve serving others, listening to their needs, and providing practical support. By demonstrating love, we can experience the joy and connection that come from building meaningful relationships and reflecting God's love to others.

Developing kingdom priorities and values requires intentionality and commitment. As believers, we must prioritise our relationship with God, seek His kingdom, and live out kingdom values in our daily lives. By doing so, we can experience the abundant life that God has promised and make a meaningful impact toward others. As the apostle Peter wrote, "According as His divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him that hath called us to glory and virtue:" (2 Peter 1:3).

May we be empowered by the Holy Spirit to live a life that reflects His love and values, bringing glory to His name and advancing His Kingdom in our world.
