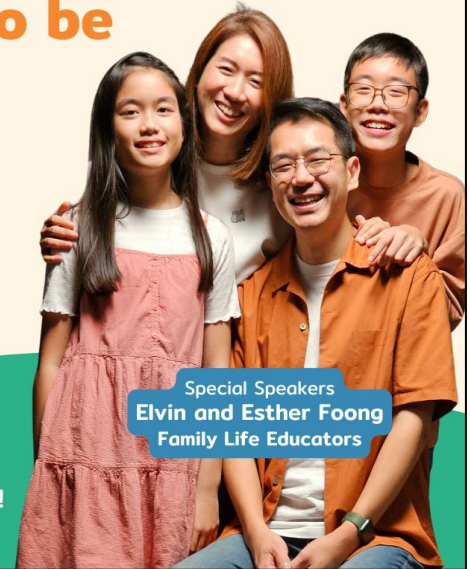

Rev David Cher, Lord's Day, 10 August 2025

Beloved Brethren,
