

We Are God's Faithful Missioners

Rev David Cher, Lord's Day, 08 March 2026

Beloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

As Christians, we've been called to something bigger than ourselves – **we are God's missioners in a world that needs the Gospel**. From Genesis to Revelation, Scripture shows God's heart for all nations. In Genesis 12:3, God promises Abraham that "all peoples on earth will be blessed through you." Jesus echoes this in Acts 1:8, saying, "You will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." This theme culminates in Revelation 7:9-10, where we see people from "every nation, tribe, and language" worshipping God together. We're part of this grand story, sent to share God's love and message of salvation.

So how do we live out this mission? In 1 Corinthians 9:19-23, Paul shows us the importance of adapting to others – becoming "all things to all people" to win some. **Having a missional heart means engaging with others without compromising our values, sharing the Gospel with clarity and compassion.** This means listening, learning, and loving people where they're at. We join in their joys and struggles, building relationships that open doors to share Jesus. Whether it's a colleague, neighbour, or friend, we can be intentional about understanding their story and sharing ours.

We surely do not do this alone – we are empowered by the Holy Spirit (Acts 1:8, Eph 3:16-17). As we rely on God's strength, we become His effective missioners, shining His Gospel light in dark places. The Spirit guides us to share the Gospel with boldness and wisdom, giving us words to speak and actions to show God's love. He also connects us to a community of believers, equipping us to work together in mission. Through His power, we are courageous, compassionate, and committed to making disciples.

We can also partner with missions agencies and organizations that carry out God's Gospel work in other countries. These agencies and organisations bring expertise, networks, and access to areas we cannot reach alone. Whether through prayer, giving, short-term trips, or long-term service, we can join God's global mission to make disciples of all nations (Matt 28:19-20). By partnering together, we advance the Gospel across borders, cultures, and languages.

Last year, our church had teams serving in both North and South Vietnam co-labouring with our missions partners to run the children's camps, sharing God's love and truth with the children who came. However, due to financial constraints, political instability and limited resources, we had to scale back some of our planned trips to Kenya, India and Myanmar. Moving forward to this year of 2026, we are not only trusting God to open these closed doors in future years but also to provide us with new missions places, opportunities and approaches to widen our missions horizon. May we have open hearts and minds to embrace God's leading, be sensitive to the Spirit's prompting, and step out in faith to share the Gospel with all nations.

As we look ahead to this year and what lies ahead for us, **let's pray for God's guidance, provision, and open doors for our missions efforts.** May we be faithful in prayer, generous in giving, and courageous in going. Let's ask God to give us fresh vision, renewed passion, and practical steps to share the Gospel with those around us, both locally and globally. May our hearts be stirred to join God's work among unreached peoples, and may we trust Him to work through us to build His kingdom. Let's commit to being part of God's story, living out our faith with purpose, and making a difference for eternity. "Go and make disciples of all nations" (Matthew 28:19). God Bless.
