

Rediscovering Our Sabbath Rest

Rev David Cher, Lord's Day, 22 March 2026

Beloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

In a culture obsessed with doing and achieving, the Sabbath boldly declares: God is enough. Our minds are conditioned to think that our value comes from our accomplishments, our busyness, and our sense of fulfilment. But the Sabbath flips this narrative in proclaiming that God's worth is not contingent on our efforts—He is the source of all value, and we are already accepted in Him.

The Sabbath is not a suggestion; it is God's gift to us (Ex 20:8-11, Mark 2:27). We often approach it as a commandment, a box to check or a duty to fulfill. **But it's a gift—one that frees us from the tyranny of our to-do lists and the relentless pursuit of productivity.** Not because we need rest (though we desperately do), but because God is the ultimate goal (Gen 2:1-3, Ex 31:17).

Not my work, not my achievements, not even my spiritual growth. **This is the radical truth of the Sabbath. It is not about what we do for God, but about what God has done for us (Gen. 2:1-3, Heb. 4:3-5).** When we rest, we acknowledge that He is our Creator, Sustainer, and Fulfilment. We trust that His provision is greater than our productivity, and His Presence is more satisfying than any personal fulfilment we could chase.

But let us be clear: the Sabbath is not just about us—our rest, our renewal, our spiritual high. That's a reduction of something far greater. The Sabbath is about **acknowledging God's sovereignty**, trusting His provision, and aligning ourselves with His eternal purposes. It is a statement that says, "You, Lord, are enough." In the Sabbath, we affirm God's reign, His kingdom, and His glory."

This reorientation transforms how we live. Monday to Saturday, we work with God; Sunday, we rest in Him. **Our labour is redeemed because our worth**

is secure. We do not strive for God's love—we rest in it. And from that rest flows true worship, true service, true life (John 15:1-5, Matt 11:28-30). Our work becomes a response to God's love, not a means to earn it.

But this does not mean the Sabbath is easy. In fact, it is counterintuitive. We have to wrestle with ourselves to stop, disconnect, and trust. It's a choice to opt into God's way of thinking, not the world's. The Sabbath shines a light on our heart's deepest drivers—what we love, what we fear, what we trust. **Will we believe God is enough? Will we surrender our agendas, our timelines, our need for control?"**

Practically, how do we keep the Sabbath holy? We set apart time, yes—but also attention. We lay down work, yes—but also worries. **We feast, we worship, we abide in God's presence (Ps 92:1-2, Lev 23:3).** We join the heavenly chorus where angels worship and rest in God's glory (Rev 4:8, Isa 6:3). In this moment, we catch a glimpse of eternity and savour God's goodness.

As we enter this rest, we are transformed by God's goodness. Our priorities shift, our hearts renewed, and our love for Him grows. We become more like Jesus, who invites, **'Come and rest' (Matt 11:28).** In His presence, we find true rest—soul-refreshing, life-reorienting rest that recalibrates our deepest desires toward Him. Our souls align with His heart, and we are drawn into the beauty of His love, finding satisfaction in the One who is enough.

And when the Sabbath ends, we do not return to our old ways. We carry the peace of God's Presence into our work, our relationships, and our daily routines. We live as people who have been with God, reflecting His love and goodness to a world that is weary and worn. **Our lives become an extension of the Sabbath, a living echo of God's faithfulness.** This is the power of the Sabbath—it reshapes our week, our work, and our witness.
