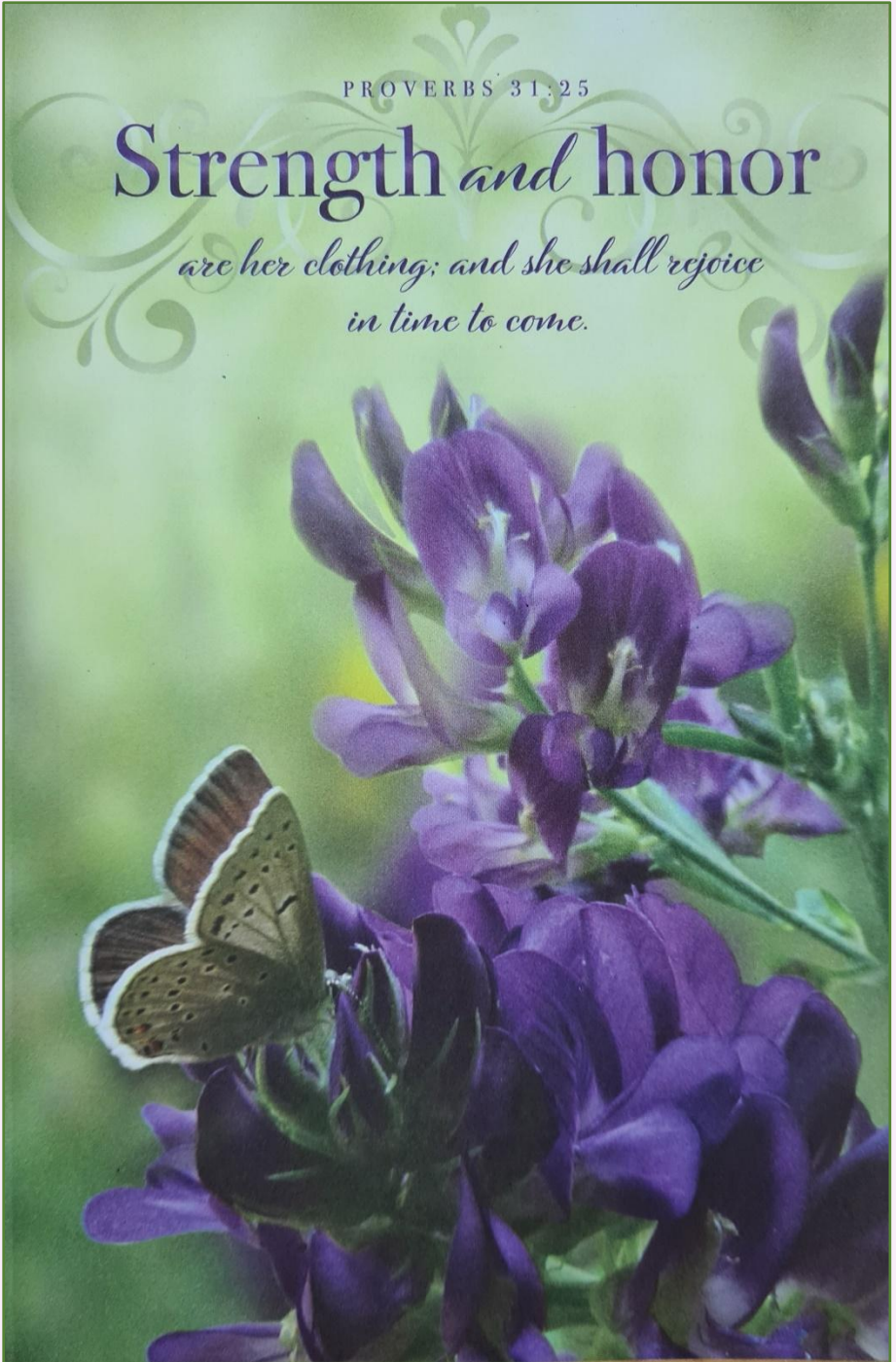

Mothers Raising The Lord's Heritage

Rev David Cher, Lord's Day, 10 May 2026

Beloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. As we celebrate Mother's Day today, we are reminded of two key facts that **healthy families are the foundation and building blocks of a stable and growing nation as well as the local churches**, and that each family member whether as husband, wife, or children play and contribute toward the building up of their families.

Parents are given the role and responsibility from God to **steward, nurture, and care for their children** to ensure that they grow not only physically, but also spiritually, socially, mentally, and emotionally, following the pattern of our Lord Jesus Christ (Luke 2:52 "And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favour with God and man"). Oftentimes, parents including myself and my wife have our time stretched with our work, family, and other commitments. Thus, it is extremely easy for us to slip into just merely moving from one activity to another without the intentionality of investing deeply into the lives of our children. In addition, our energies are drained at the end of the day when we get back with our families. At this point, parents are reminded to carefully monitor and manage our emotions and feelings such that we do not jeopardise the proper bringing up of our children (Eph. 6:4 "And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord").

The responsibility of raising a godly family does not lie with the husband alone. God declared, "It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him" (Gen. 2:18). As a "help meet" — a strong ally — the wife shares in the work of parenting with her husband. The husband is to provide loving,

Christ-like leadership for the family (Eph. 5:23), and the wife is to lovingly and respectfully support him in that calling (Eph. 5:22).

In this partnership, the wife also reflects God's own heart of comfort (Isaiah 66:13 "As one whom his mother comforteth, so will I comfort you"), **bringing an approachable, relatable tenderness to the children as she helps her husband lead**. But compassion is not hers alone — fathers too must lead with tenderness, "lest they be discouraged" (Col. 3:21). When husband and wife each model both instruction and compassion, children see the full character of God: His holiness and His mercy, His truth and His tenderness, all under one roof.

Our attention as parents should also not be only on the present, but also **focusing on training and developing their person and character for what lies ahead for them in the future** (Prov. 22:6 "Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it"). This is far more important than leaving to them mere material and physical riches (Prov. 13:22 "A good man leaveth an inheritance to his children's children: and the wealth of the sinner is laid up for the just"). The inheritance of the good man as mentioned in Proverbs 13:22 has a much wider range of good moral stability and goodness as compared to the transient or temporal nature of wealth or riches.

May God grant all parents **His wisdom and guidance as to how we are to lead and guide our families in His ways** (Ps. 127:1, 3 "Except the Lord build the house, they labour in vain that build it: except the Lord keep the city, the watchman waketh but in vain... Lo, children are an heritage of the Lord: and the fruit of the womb is His reward"). God Bless!
