God Careth For You!

Pastor Simon, Lord's Day, 17 May 2026

Brethren, Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ! Hymn writer, C.D. Martin, penned, "No matter what the test may be, God will take care of you. Lean, weary one, upon His breast; God will take care of you" In every season of life, concerns and anxieties show up at our doorstep, one after another, regrettably, non-stop. Sometimes, as the saying goes, "It never rains. It pours. -- Remember the times we fretted over multiple cares at the same time? The reality is we live in an anxiety-ridden age, spinning along in a fast-paced world. If we do not know how to manage life stress and cope well with the cares of life, we can easily become discouraged, distressed, or even depressed.

The indispensable, precious Word of God encourages us when life's burdens are too heavy to bear: Come to the Lord. Christ Himself said, "Come to Me, all you who labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy and My burden is light." Matt 11:28-30. The Apostle Peter encouraged believers who were enduring persecution for their faith to cast all their cares [anxiety, worry, fear] upon the Lord, for He cares for them (1 Peter 5:7). There is enormous wisdom in Scripture for our well-being. We are to surrender all and cast the full weight of our care upon Jesus, our Lord, for He cares for us! How blessed we are, and what great comfort offered! We can hide safely in the Shelter of the Almighty in the time of a storm.

There are two kinds of care in 1 Peter 5:7, our anxious care and the Lord's affectionate care. First, let us look at "cast all your care." The Greek understanding of care or anxiety is a divided mind or anxious interest. The concept of a divided mind is losing focus or attempting to focus on too many things. Webster's Dictionary defines anxiety as "a painful or apprehensive uneasiness of mind usually over an anticipated or impending situation or a strong fearful concern." George Mueller puts it aptly: "The beginning of anxiety is the end of faith, and the beginning of true faith is the end of anxiety."

Anxiety is detrimental and offers no benefit to our lives. Anxiety robs our joy in life, steals our contentment, erodes our confidence and creates in us a tremendous level of angst and gradually undermines our trust in God. Brethren, when anxiety assails us, remember we have a God who cares for us, and He invites us to cast "ALL" our care upon Him—big or small, significant or trivial, spiritual or material. Brethren, our Creator God who holds and sustains the immensity of the universe, the splendour of the galaxy and the glorious nature invites us to commit our every care to Him and trust Him to lead and guide us.

Next, we look at our Lord's tender, loving, gracious and compassionate care, which we have all tasted repeatedly. Like the psalmist, we too can proclaim, "Oh, taste and see that the Lord is good; Blessed is the man who trusts in Him!" Ps 34:8. He knows us and understands our every need, even our weaknesses, our strengths. When we are cumbered with a load of care, we can go to God our Refuge. He is waiting, and He wants us to hand over to Him all our fears, worries and anxiety. Not a part of it, not some of it, not most of it -- but ALL of it! Are we keen?

Why don't we do just that? God cares for His own. The same Mighty Hand that crafted the magnificent universe wants to craft our lives for His glory. The same Voice that spoke light into existence is calling our names. The Creator of Heaven and Earth loves us and is concerned about us and everything in our lives. Isn't it amazing! Indeed, what a Friend we have in Jesus, all our sins, grief, and care to bear! Come to Jesus, our Shield, our Rock, and Comforter! We can confidently entrust our lives into the Hands of our loving Heavenly Father and abide in the Shelter of the Almighty.

Brethren, God is worthy of our absolute trust. He can, and He will take care of us right down to the smallest aspect of life, even our daily routine. All our tomorrows are secure in His Hands! Beloved children of God, rejoice and rest in the tender loving care of God. God Bless!
