Under The Shadow Of The Almighty

Rev David Cher, Lord's Day, 31 May 2026

Beloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Have you ever felt the weight of pressure close in during a season of struggle? When everything feels unsteady, where do you run for refuge?

Psalms 91:1 doesn't give us a formula, but a place to live: "He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty." "Shadow" can bring to mind "the valley of the shadow of death" in Psalm 23:4. But here it's the opposite. Think of a massive tree overhanging a sun-scorched path. Step beneath it, and the heat breaks. The noise quiets. Your shoulders drop. This is refuge, not escape — because you are held by the One greater than it all. When we dwell here, fear loses its grip. We find rest, not because circumstances change, but because God does not.

Corrie ten Boom lived this out. An ordinary woman in the Netherlands, she and her family risked everything to hide Jews from the Nazis during the Second World War. Arrested and sent to Ravensbrück concentration camp with her sister Betsie, she endured suffering most of us can't imagine. Yet her letters and testimony showed a spirit unshaken. Battles raged around her, but her anchor held. "The Lord was my dwelling place," she lived as if it were true, because it was. In the worst place on earth, she found the secret place.

God's offer is simple and always available: draw near to Him. The shadow is available, but we must step into it. This is not a one-time sprint to the mercy seat when crisis hits. As Charles Spurgeon puts it, "Every child of God looks towards the inner sanctuary and the mercy seat, yet all do not dwell in the most holy place; they

run to it at times, and enjoy occasional approaches, but they do not habitually reside in the mysterious presence."

If we only run to God in emergencies, we stay spiritually out of breath. But when we make His Word and prayer our daily rhythm, the clutter clears. Our hearts re-center, and the noise of anxiety loses its grip because we are listening to a louder voice. And this shelter isn't empty. Psalm 91:2 declares, "I will say of the Lord, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in Him will I trust."

Trusting Him doesn't make life easier. It makes us willing to move when He says move — even when it takes us out of our comfort zone. Trusting God means moving when He says move. Joshua had to lead Israel into Canaan right after Moses died, facing giants and fortified cities. Fear would have been reasonable. But God's word held firm: "Be strong and courageous... for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go" [Joshua 1:9]. Joshua moved not because he felt ready, but because God was with him. Trusting God doesn't remove the giants. It reminds you that the One ahead of you is greater.

When you dwell with Him daily, you gain a steady heart and a peace that guards it [Phil. 4:7]. Like a tree planted by water, you stay rooted and fruitful even when the heat comes [Jer. 17:7-8]. The storms don't uproot you because your life is anchored in the One who doesn't change. So step out of the sun. Rest under His shadow today, lay down the weight you have been carrying, and let Him be your refuge again.
