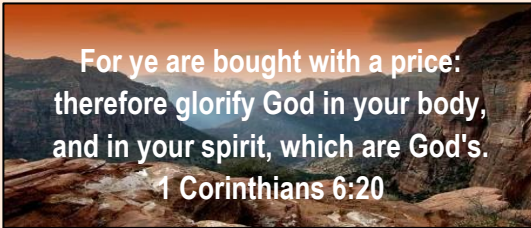

Remembering the Lord's Goodness!

Pastor Simon, Lord's Day, 7 June 2026

Brethren,
Blessed 66th Church Anniversary & Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ! Indeed, this is a joyous occasion for the church. Since her inception, our Chief Shepherd [1 Pet 5:4], Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ, has been intentionally and faithfully leading the Galilee congregation, fulfilling His plans in and through us [Jer 29:11].

We glorify the Head of our church [Col 1:18], our Lord, for His goodness and mercies upon Galileans for the last 66 years. Our church has experienced all kinds of weather and would readily and boldly testify to His faithfulness, unlimited grace, and boundless mercy over the decades. Our predecessors overcame varied challenges, shrouded in the unknown, with tiresome climbs and intimidating descents, solving complex problems and tenaciously adapting to evolving changes. It is by His grace that we have stayed together as a church, functioned unitedly during challenging times, persevered resolutely, and persisted victoriously through the Help and guidance of the Great Shepherd of the sheep [Heb 13:20], our Lord.

Going forward, as a church, let us motivate one another with encouraging words and spur on fellow believers to fruitful and faithful service for God. Scriptures instruct us to "encourage one another and build each other up..." 1 Thess 5:11. "Encouragement" is a beautiful, blessed word, yet many in our community are famished for it. We may be different, but not redundant or useless. Intentionally, the Lord created us uniquely different and gifted us in varied ways. This manner of design promoted interdependence, dignity and purposefulness. Hence, we ought to speak thoughtfully and sensitively with one another. A fork-and-spoon illustration comes to my mind. This cutlery is individually different and designed for a specific purpose. The fork is ineffective when the soup arrives; similarly, the spoon when the noodles arrive. As we work, we verbalise our thoughts, observations, and suggestions. We must use kind and caring words that will encourage, cheer up, instil hope, and strengthen the other person.

Next, we must "build one another"—It is the church's corporate responsibility. The phrase "build each other up" draws on the imagery of building a house or strengthening a structure. Spiritually, it means helping fellow believers become stronger, steadier, more mature, and more faithful in Christ. It goes beyond making people feel better emotionally. Encouragement comforts the heart; building up strengthens the whole Christian life. How could we build up a fellow brother or sister? Suggestions—First, always point people to the Lord and His Word. When and where appropriate, share testimonies of God's faithfulness. Next, when a fellow believer does a certain thing rightly in the Lord, give sincere affirmation. In the same breath, if you notice inappropriateness in conduct or theology, then prayerfully, humbly correct the person, but gently. Display interest and willingness to bear each other's burden. A church grows strong when believers are attentive to Christ and responsive to the needs of His people.

Besides the Body of believers, we also need to be mindful of the lost world right outside the church doors. The church's mission to the lost world remains integral. The Gospel is the hope for humanity that struggles in a complex political matrix, social unrest, financial upheavals, and climatic challenges. In our Sunday Sermons, Bible studies, Sunday School classes, music ministry, SSG programme, and other ministries, the evangelism element must remain essential. Galilee will play a conscious role in the place where the Lord has planted us. We capitalise existing resources and knowledge and create opportunities to bring the church into the neighbourhood. Through the St. Luke's partnership, the RFM program, and the Community Day programme, we have made our presence felt. God willing, we will explore other suitable avenues for Gospel outreach.

May the Lord bless us and keep us: the Lord make His face shine upon us and be gracious unto us: the Lord lift up His countenance upon us and give us peace [Numbers 6:24-26].
