

Repurposed and Realigned

Rev David Cher, Lord's Day, 14 June 2026

Beloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. As we draw near to church camp, even for those of us who are not going for our own reasons, this annual event still serves as an important reminder in the middle of life's busyness. Before the next season pulls us in a myriad of different directions — new demands, new pressures, new decisions — God calls a halt. We certainly are not escaping life — we are re-entering it with clarity and strength. Because the easiest way to lose your way is to never stop and check your direction. **In that pause, the drift stops. The realignment starts.**

In that pause, God gets to work. He does not just let us rest — He remakes us. Time with Him removes the weight that is not ours: fear, guilt, old habits, constant noise. Worship brings calm. Truth brings clarity. Prayer restores strength. Community reminds us we don't fight alone. **This is where we stop surviving and start standing.** We stop patching and let God rebuild. We will not walk away the same — we will be repurposed and realigned.

God puts everything back in order. Life has a way of shifting our priorities without us noticing — urgent things become important things. When we pause before Him, He reorders our focus. What we value gets reset. What we chase gets corrected. We stop running from one thing to the next and start walking in step with what really and ultimately matters. **Alignment is not just feeling good. It's knowing where your feet are planted.**

Distractions lose their power here. The noise

fades, the pressure drops, and suddenly you can hear clearly again. Time with God clears the clutter from your mind and your heart. You remember why you started and who you are called to be. Vision gets sharp again. Purpose gets loud again. **When you rise from prayer, you do not just have more motivation — you have direction.**

God does not just fix what is broken. He brings new life to what is tired. In His presence, dry places get watered. Faith that has been running on empty gets refilled. Your "yes" to God gets fresh fire. You come in worn out. You leave with new strength, new hope, and a new hunger. **Renewal is not a feeling — it is fuel for the next season.**

But here is the truth: what draws you to God is the same thing the Devil will try to steal when you step back into routine. Distractions will return. Pressure will come back. Old patterns will knock. That is why this pause matters. You're not just getting refilled — you are getting equipped. **Repurposed people do not get surprised by attacks. They are trained for them.**

This is the turning point. In God's pause, you decide what you will lay down, what you will give Him, and who you will be under pressure. The resolve you make in the quiet place carries you through the valley. **Days of clarity create a year of consistency.**

Time set apart with God prepares you for every week ahead. When life pulls, you will not drift. When shortcuts call, you will not bend. When challenges rise, you will stand — repurposed, realigned, ready. God bless!
