Storm without, Peace within!

Pastor Simon, Lord's Day, 21 June 2026

Brethren,
Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ! Few things (if anything at all) in this fallen world are perfect. Our life journey can be awful at times, if not for the Lord's preservation. When sickness, pain, suffering, financial hardships, the death of a loved one, fractured relationships, or shattered dreams—any one of these situations could send tremors to our wellbeing and threaten to overwhelm us. Naturally, we become weary, distressed, and discouraged; fear and doubt grip us, and we are tossed about like a rag doll. We may

even find it difficult to pray, let alone go to church. How and where do we find peace, courage and fortitude to stay steady amidst horrendous "storms" of life? We can do two things—either we trust God and His promises to us or throw ourselves headlong into the whirlpool of rough times. The prophet Jeremiah writes, “Blessed is the man who trusts in the Lord, and whose hope is the Lord.” Jer 17:7. When we simply, in child-like faith, entrust ourselves to this counsel, we will assuredly experience perfect peace while journeying through life challenges—“Thou [the Lord] wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on Thee: because he trusts in Thee” (Isa 26:3).

Why do we keep carrying the burdens of life on our frail shoulders when all we need to do is to trust God absolutely, and commit all our cares, worries and anxieties to Him? I believe we are afraid that things will not go the way we want unless we control them ourselves. We struggle to let go. And the less we are in control of a situation in life, the more anxious we will become because we worry that it will not go right [the way we want it to be]. Next, there are times when we foolishly resign ourselves to thinking that our situation is hopeless, too far gone to be salvaged. We either procrastinate or get "paralysed" by our situation, thinking that if we cannot resolve the problem ourselves, God would probably not intervene to deliver us from it. The actual situation speaks for itself, except for a miracle, which happens so rarely in ordinary life.

How foolish! We must never, ever, stop believing in God! Exercising increasing faith and trust in God and His Promises, believing in God absolutely in all of life's situations, is a personal response that grows out of a close, intimate relationship with the Lord. Brethren, during life's struggles, our minds must stay riveted on Jesus, the Prince of Peace, and we will find in Him, as He has promised, Perfect Peace and rest. This has been the blessed experience of countless believers over the ages, and it can be ours too. Even when, after much prayer, the situation did not show

the anticipated improvement, we humbly accept His will, humming the hymn, “It is well with my soul!”

The Lord Jesus has promised to give us peace in our crisis. Just hours before His own Crucifixion, Christ knew the turbulent wave of events the Disciples would soon have to face, and He comforted them thus: “Peace I leave with you, My peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid” (Jn 14:27). Thank God for a loving Saviour Who understands us, cares for us and provides for us and journeys with us in every aspect of life. Richard Fuller, a 19th-century eloquent Minister of the Lord, related what an old, experienced seaman said: “In a fierce storm, we must put the ship in a certain position and keep her there”. Said Fuller, “This, Christian, is what you must do... You must put your soul in one position and keep it there. You must stay upon the Lord; and, come what may — winds, waves, cross seas, thunder, lightning, frowning rocks, roaring breakers — no matter what, you must hold fast your confidence in God's faithfulness and His everlasting love in Christ Jesus.”

Brethren, are you "broken" and overwhelmed by your troubles today? Anchor your mind on the Lord Jesus. The One Who controls the howling winds and the choppy sea can calm the "storms" and restore tranquillity to our lives. Perfect peace is in Christ alone! God Bless!
