Mind Transformation!

Pastor Simon, Lord's Day, 5 July 2026

Brethren, Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ! The Apostle Paul challenges the Philippian Christians: "Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus" (Phil 2:5). This is one of the most exciting invitations in the Word of God. Paul tells his readers that redeemed people can rise to the point of thinking with the mind of Jesus Christ. Indeed, this should be our continual quest, the object of our prayer day by day, that we might have the mind of Christ as we face the issues of life.

We do not naturally think with the mind of Christ. Consequently, we do not live and serve as Christ lived and served. Brethren, we will never become Christ-like in our conduct until we become Christ-like in our thought-life (Isa 55:7-8). The unrighteous man must forsake his unrighteous thoughts if he wants to disconnect himself from his wicked ways. Repentance is not just an act by itself; it must come from the heart and soul. Repentance does not take place in a moment; it should be continual. Repentance has been described as a pilgrimage from the mind of the flesh to the mind of the Spirit. The call to repentance is in reality a call to accept the mind of Christ and to live by it. Paul tells us that with the help of the Holy Spirit, we can have the mind of Jesus Christ and live Christ-like, to the glory of His Name.

For instance, let's consider Zacchaeus, the tax collector. It has been his quest to gather by any means wealth and comfort for his family. His profession enabled him to do so by corruptly taxing the people. He was already much disliked by his community, not only for his corrupt practices but also for serving a foreign government. His family was ostracised by his own people. Zacchaeus felt justified in extracting taxes from such people. But when Christ came into his life, his mind changed upside down. His greed left him. He became a generous giver to the community (Lk 19:1-10).

The mind of Christ calls for humility and surrender to the Will of God (Jn 5:30). Our Lord expressed humility and total commitment to His Father's Will by being willing to clothe Himself in human flesh -- to the point that He became a servant and yielded Himself in service to suffer a shameful death on a cross (Phil 2:7-8). This is the example set by Christ that Paul holds up for us to emulate.

When we live by the mind of Christ, we would be found serving God diligently and faithfully and fulfilling His purposes for our lives. Our Lord Jesus was a worker (Jn 9:4). He believed with all His heart that the greatest joy in life came from giving rather than getting. Scripture describes our Lord as one who went about doing good (Acts 10:38). Paul tells the Ephesian Christians that God has created us to give ourselves to a life of good works (Eph 2:10) and to bear fruit for Him.

The mind of Christ calls for compassion as well. When our Lord saw the multitude, He was moved with compassion rather than with a critical attitude (Matt 9:36). If we would be true followers of Jesus Christ, we must let the love of God within us express itself in loving concern and help for the needy. Compassion should flood our hearts not only to the people around us but also to those who suffer the ravages of war, pestilence, natural disasters and calamities in other lands. And compassion must express itself in action to be genuine. Our Lord suffered with those around Him and gave Himself unreservedly in meeting the needs of others.

Brethren, to have the mind of Christ will be costly. It will involve hardship, inconvenience, and sacrifices, but it will change the course of our lives and produce a profound transformation within us, giving us meaning and purpose. When faced with the problems and potentials of life, with the mind of Christ, we will grow to be more Christ-like. May God help us.
