# Your Work Matters To God

Rev David Cher, Lord's Day, 12 July 2026

**B**eloved Brethren,  
When we hear the word “work,” we often picture tasks, responsibilities, and deadlines. Left unchecked, this view can turn work into drudgery, and even dread. Yet this weariness often comes when we lose sight of the deeper purpose of our labour. Scripture reminds us that our work is not separate from God's mission. It is surely an important part of the calling He has placed in our lives.

Therefore, we must understand that work itself is not a curse. In fact, work is part of God's original and good design for mankind. Before sin ever entered the world, God placed Adam in the Garden of Eden “to work it and keep it” [Genesis 2:15]. This means that purposeful labour was given as a blessing, not a burden. To cultivate, to care for, and to create was meant to be a joyful partnership with our Creator.

It was only after the fall of Adam and Eve that work became toilsome and difficult. Because of sin, God told Adam, “Cursed is the ground because of you... In the sweat of your face you shall eat bread” [Genesis 3:17, 19]. The ground now produced thorns and thistles. What was once joyful cultivation became labour marked by frustration, fatigue, and struggle.

Yet even in a broken world, work did not lose its dignity. God did not remove the calling to work after the fall; He redeemed it. The thorns remain, but so does the task. Our daily work may be harder now, but it is still an opportunity to labour with God, to provide for those we love, to bless our neighbours, and to reflect His goodness in every ordinary place He has set us. Knowing this, we are still called to work diligently with whatever the Lord has placed in our hands [Proverbs 14:23; 2 Thessalonians 3:10].

Scripture calls us to labour faithfully, and with our whole heart, for the heart is the wellspring of life [Proverbs 4:23]. When our hearts are set on the Lord, even ordinary work becomes an act of worship.

What then should we do when work becomes hard? As human beings, we are vulnerable to stress, discouragement, and setbacks that can wear us out. In those moments, we must remember that the God who placed us where we are will also give us the grace and strength we need to persevere. Isaiah reminds us of this contrast: those who rely on their own strength grow weary, but those who wait on the Lord will be renewed and empowered to keep going [Isaiah 40:30-31].

Whether we are at work, at school, or at home, our labour matters to God. We are not just earning a living or completing tasks. We are serving the Lord Christ Himself [Colossians 3:23]. When we work with integrity, diligence, and a thankful heart, we reflect Christ to a watching world, build up those around us, and find true meaning in what we do.

As such, let us not despise the work God has given us. Though it may be hard, hidden, or feel small, it is still His calling on our lives. Let us rise each day, not depending on our own strength, but on His. Let us labour for Him with all our heart, trusting that He sees, He strengthens, and He will not forget. In Christ, even ordinary work carries eternal weight [1 Corinthians 15:58]. God bless!
