Resting In God's Unchanging Hand

Rev David Cher, Lord's Day, 26 July 2026

Beloved Brethren,
Every good and perfect gift comes from above, from the Father of lights, with whom there is no change or shadow of turning (James 1:17). Because God and His blessings are with us, we can persevere through the rest of this year with confidence. Yet we know the road ahead will not always be smooth. There will be ongoing responsibilities, new challenges, and tasks that call for perseverance. **In it all, God is at work in us — giving us both the desire and the strength to do His Will (Philippians 2:13).** May we receive each assignment from His hand with ready hearts and serve wholeheartedly without grumbling (Philippians 2:14).

You may have entered this year with your own plans and resolutions. Yet you must stay sensitive to the leading of the Holy Spirit. He may redirect your path for His glory. The Apostle Paul experienced this in Acts 16:6-12. He planned to go to Bithynia, but the Spirit shut that door and led him to Macedonia instead. Paul did not resist. He trusted and obeyed. May you do the same. **When God redirects you, may you surrender in faith — trusting that the unchanging Father knows best.**

But surrender is only the beginning. To walk in God's new direction requires a heart that truly trusts and rests in Him. Discontent often grows when you forget who God is. But when your eyes are fixed on His unchanging goodness, you can receive both the smooth roads and the hard ones as gifts from His hand. **May you therefore cultivate hearts that do not complain against the Lord's providence, but instead find peace in trusting Him.** For He is working all things — the planned and the unexpected — for your good and for His glory.

But if you are honest, resting is not always easy.

Discontent is subtle in your heart. It rarely starts as rebellion. It often starts with small complaints — “This is not what I planned,” “Why is it taking so long,” “Others are ahead of me.” **Yet murmuring against your circumstances is ultimately murmuring against the God who ordained them.** Surely, discontentment steals joy, hardens the heart, and blinds us to the grace already in your hands. A complaining spirit cannot worship, and a worshipping spirit will not complain.

The question then is this: how do you keep your heart from slipping into discontent? **It begins with intentional remembrance.** We as mere human beings are prone and quick to forget. In the rush of disappointment, we forget how God has carried us before. But when we rehearse His faithfulness — the prayers He answered, the doors He shut to protect us, the manna He gave in the wilderness seasons — it steadies us in the present.

But remembrance doesn't always make the present easy. Sometimes God's providence feels like loss, delay, or silence. **In those moments, contentment is not having all the answers. It is trusting the One who does especially when you do not understand the paths He is leading you through (Prov. 3:5-6).** Faith is choosing to believe His hand is good even when His path is hard.

But the good news is this: our Heavenly Father has not changed. He is still wise enough to redirect us, still loving enough to provide for us, and still present enough to walk with us. **So we can release our grip. We can rest in Him. We can be content.** Because every closed door, every detour, and every new assignment is not leading us away from Him — it is leading us deeper into Him. God Bless!
