"First Thing First"

Pastor Simon, Lord's Day, 2 August 2026

Brethren,
Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. We live in a world that constantly competes for our attention. Every day is filled with work, family responsibilities, social commitments, financial concerns, and endless digital distractions. Our schedules are often full, yet our souls may be running on empty. The question is not whether we are busy, but whether we are busy with the right things. Perhaps the Lord knew our temptation to be drawn into various occupations without an intelligent evaluation. Befittingly, the Lord said, "Seek ye first the Kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added unto you." The word "first" underscores the importance of prioritising in our lives.

The Lord's concern is misplaced priorities. Do you realise that the Holy Bible is a book that helps set priorities according to values, teaching, and guiding Christians toward loving God, obeying Him, and living a life of blessedness with God and man, at home and at work, in church and in the community? As disciples of Jesus Christ, we are called to live intentionally. God has entrusted each of us with twenty-four hours a day. Time is one of His precious gifts, and we are stewards of it. The way we spend our time reveals what we truly value. If our calendars and priorities leave little room for God, His Word, prayer, worship, and serving others, then it is time to prayerfully reorder our priorities.

Christians are to continually check the Word of God to ensure we are on the right track in life, following the Lord Jesus and abiding in Him. We need to constantly examine where our lives are headed and whether our priorities and life goals are in sync with the Lord's Will at different phases of our lives. Is the "road" we are treading so zealously on leading us into a closer relationship with God and the blessed way to Heaven? Our Lord Jesus taught vital priorities in the Christian's life (John 21:15-19).

Let's see how Jesus tenderly restored a very discouraged and disheartened Peter in a heart-to-heart talk.

PRIORITY 1: "Lovest thou Me?" (Jn 21:15). This was Jesus' gentle prompt to Peter to re-align his heart to love the Lord supremely and be exclusively devoted to his Master and Saviour. What would be our own response to this vital question? Devotional writer Sidlow Baxter pens it so correctly: "The first thing which makes a true minister or missionary or evangelist or preacher or Sunday School teacher or Christian worker of any kind, is not learning, not eloquence, not wisdom, not organising ability, not pleasing personality, not even a 'passion of souls', but a love-passion of Jesus Himself. Nothing, absolutely nothing, can take the place of that. The Christian's paramount duty is to love the Lord supremely with an undivided heart. Jesus said "...thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment" (Mk 12:30). It will do us well to take periodic "heart-checks" and conscientiously work at re-arranging our lives to grow in a loving, intimate relationship with the Lord.

PRIORITY 2: "Follow Me" (Jn 21:19).

Our Lord was reminding His Disciple Peter to fix his eyes on Jesus Himself and follow Him. A faithful servant of the Lord is an obedient and humble follower of Jesus. We are reminded here that we are not to live as we please, or follow our feelings and experiences, not to shift our loyalty away from Christ to follow after man, not to practise unquestioningly the traditions of culture or the norms of society that are not in line with God's Word, not to seek after philosophies and wisdom of the world that go contrary to the practice of our faith in Jesus Christ. We are to follow only the Great Shepherd, Our Lord, and Master Jesus Christ – then will we manage our priorities. God Bless!
