Finding Rest, Peace and Strength in Christ

Rev David Cher, Lord's Day, 13 Sept 2026

Beloved Brethren,
We live in a noisy, hurried world that constantly teaches us to rely on ourselves. Even our faith can start to feel like another item on the to-do list. But God never called us to manage Him like a task. He called us to walk with Him — to find rest in Him, to make space to hear His voice above the noise, and to find the courage in our hearts to follow Him one faithful step at a time.

As pilgrims on this earth (1 Peter 2:11-12), we are familiar with spiritual highs and lows. One week, we can feel close to God, but the next week, we feel distant and dry. Life as we know it can pull us off course without us realizing it. John Bunyan pictured this struggle well in *The Pilgrim's Progress*. As Pilgrim journeys toward the Celestial City, he battles despondency, fear, and discouragement that threaten to drag him into the Slough or off the narrow path. If he struggled, we will too. So how do we, as spiritual pilgrims, keep our eyes fixed on God and keep walking with Him through both the mountaintops and the valleys?

Just like physical tiredness is a signal that our bodies need rest, spiritual weariness is a signal that our souls need rest. We were never designed to carry the full weight of life, worry, and sin on our own shoulders. That is why Jesus gives such a tender and personal invitation: "Come to me, all who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest" Matt. 11:28. St. Augustine of Hippo also put it in this way: "You have made us for yourself, O Lord, and our hearts are restless until they rest in you."

When Jesus gives us rest, He also gives us direction for the road ahead. We stop dragging the heavy weight of sin and self-effort, and we start "looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith" Heb. 12:2. In Him, we are new

creations and the old has gone (2 Cor. 5:17). This focus on Christ is not just a spiritual feeling that comes and goes. It's intentional and practical. It shapes how we think when anxiety rises, how we choose when we're tempted, and how we live with Him in the ordinary moments of everyday life.

Focusing on Christ does not automatically remove every problem from our lives. But it does give us something better — God's peace in the middle of them (Col. 3:15). His peace is different from what the world offers or can give to us. Its permanence is because it is anchored in His unchanging presence, not in our changing problems. That is why Scripture keeps inviting us to hand Him everything: "Cast all your anxiety on him, because he cares for you" (1 Peter 5:7).

And this peace reshapes how we see everything. Instead of being stuck in earthly frustrations and disappointments, we begin to view our circumstances from a heavenly perspective. Scripture promises that God renews the strength of those who wait on Him (Isaiah 40:31). As we trust Him and keep our minds stayed on Him, He gives us fresh joy and the strength to keep shining for Him, no matter what season we're walking through.

Living with this perspective does not mean life gets easier. The deadlines will still come. Relationships may still be strained. The future may still be unclear. But with Christ at the center, He gives us what we need — patience instead of panic, faith instead of fear, and grace instead of bitterness. The comfort and assurance that we have is that we are not walking alone, but with the One who holds all things together.

Walking with God means daily rest, peace, and strength in Christ. "You keep him in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on You, because he trusts in You" Isaiah 26:3. God Bless!
