“Cast Your Cares!”

Pastor Simon, Lord's Day, 20 September 2026

Brethren,
Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. In every season of life, concerns and anxieties do show up at our doorstep, one after another. Sometimes, as the saying goes: "It never rains. It pours" -- remember the times we fretted over multiple cares at the same time? The reality is we live in an anxiety-ridden age, spinning along in a fast-paced world. And if we do not know how to manage life stress and cope well with the cares of life, we will get easily discouraged, distressed, even depressed. God's precious Word encourages us when life's burdens are too heavy to bear: bring them to the Lord— "Casting ALL your care [anxiety, worry, fear] upon Him; for He careth for you" (1Pet 5:7). There is enormous wisdom in this command. We are to surrender all issues and cast the whole weight of our care upon Jesus our Lord, for He cares for us! How blessed we are and what precious comfort! We can hide safely in the Shelter of the Almighty in the time of storm.

There are two kinds of care in this Scripture text - our anxious care and the Lord's affectionate care. Let's look firstly at "cast all your care". The Greek understanding of care or anxiety is to have a divided mind or an anxious interest. The concept of a divided mind is losing focus or attempting to focus on too many things. Webster Dictionary defines anxiety as "a painful or apprehensive uneasiness of mind usually over an anticipated or impending situation or a strong fearful concern". George Mueller puts it so correctly: "The beginning of anxiety is the end of faith, and the beginning of true faith is the end of anxiety". Anxiety is detrimental and does nothing of benefit to our lives. In fact, anxiety robs us of our joy in life. Anxiety steals our contentment. Anxiety erodes our confidence and causes us to fear. Anxiety steals our ability to trust God. But we

have a God Who invites us to cast "ALL" our care upon Him -- big or small, major or trivial, spiritual or material. We get ourselves into trouble when we use our own "cleverness" to choose things we think we can handle on our own, and things which we will commit to the Lord. Brethren, the God Who holds the whole world in His Hand says we are to commit our every care unto Him. Are we?

Secondly, we look at our Lord's tender, loving, gracious and compassionate care. God wants to lift our burdens and alleviate our anxiety. God knows everything. He knows our pain, sorrow and hurt. He knows our weaknesses and failures. He knows our every need. When we are cumbered with a load of care, we can go to God our Refuge. He is waiting for us to go to Him. God wants us to hand over to Him all our nervous tension and anxiety. Not part of it, not some of it, not most of it -- but ALL of it! Brethren, why don't we do just that? God cares for us. He loves us. He knows us better than we know ourselves. The same Mighty Hand that crafted the universe wants to craft our life. The same Voice that spoke light into existence is calling our names. The Maker of Heaven and Earth is concerned about us and everything in our life. Isn't that amazing! Is there anyone out there, a friend or relative, who could offer such a powerful promise, except the Almighty Lord? What a Friend we have in Jesus, and relative (Heb 2:11; Rom 8:29; Mk 3:34) all our sins, griefs and care to bear! Come to Jesus, our Shield and Comforter!

Brethren, God is worthy of our absolute trust. He can, and He will take care of us right down to the smallest aspect of life, even our daily routine. Pray and trust God and His Word. We can place all our tomorrows securely into His Hand! This is the blessedness of the children of God basking in the tender loving care of God, our Heavenly Father! Amen!
